

To actually count all of the initiatives and achievements carried out by Secot during this long time frame is not an easy task or one that is in my reach. 





## 07 HIGHLIGHTED PROJECTS AND ACTIONS



### EXPLORER SDG: 4 / 8 / 17

Objective: To provide those selected with the necessary support to carry out their idea. A network of professionals offering consulting and personal training in business matters, a platform for collaborative work in line with administrative and legal support in case the idea can be carried out into a business project. The project is conducted by Centro Internacional Santander Emprendimiento (CISE), and is integrated in the University of Cantabria for the study and investigation of the financial sector(UCEIF). Explorer has the sponsorship of Banco Santander, through the Santander Universities.

Beneficiaries: 690 young participants between 18 - 30 years old with technological business ideas.

#### Implementation and Development:

314 Seniors from SECOT have developed 2,065 actions of mentoring within this program in 42 EXPLORER centers. A total of 5,341 hours of training and mentoring were completed. The offices that participated in the project were from the following branches and offices: Alava, Aragon, Asturias, Barcelona, Baleares, Cantabria, Castellon, Granada, Guipuzoa, Jaen, Jerez, La Coruña, La Rioja, Leon,(Palencia). Lleida, Madrid Malaga, Murcia, Pamplona, Salamanca, Sevilla, Tarragona, Valencia, Valladolid, and Vizcaya.



### ESADE SDG: 4 / 8 / 17

Objective: ESADE BUSINESS SCHOOL has three units of activity: MBA Executive education and university management programs. The degree in Business Administration adapted to the Bologna Plan in the BBA. The SECOT Seniors participate within the BBA as academic tutors for the PRACTICUM, a subject in which students have internships in an entity. In the last course of the BBA and within the final projects in order to earn the degree, the Seniors also participate in two of the three areas: The final dissertation where not only do they tutor but also propose the subject and script for the project, and also on the IN-COMPANY PROJECT in which students carry out a project that is chosen by the entity where the internship took place.

Beneficiaries: Students from ESADE, a total of 113, on this particular occasion received from the Secot Seniors the knowledge, wide experience in the business world, and the necessary dedication so that the contribution could be successful.

Implementation and Development: 22 Seniors participated in 1,840 hours





## RED INNPRENDE

**SDG: 4 / 8 / 17**

### Objective:

To generate new projects and feasible business in the hospitality, tourism, food and agricultural sectors of Andalusia.

### Beneficiaries:

15 selected projects, 15 entrepreneurs mentored by Seniors of Secot in Huelva, Jaen, Cadiz. Granada, Sevilla, Malaga, Pais Vasco and Madrid.

### Implementation and Development:

(10 in total) tutor the selected entrepreneurs so that they acquire the necessary abilities and capacities in order to design, develop, and present their own business project. They have held 3 training workshops of two hours duration each participating in coworking sessions and training. They also assisted 5 training requests dedicating 18 hours to this activity carried out by 5 Secot Seniors.

## REDESSA

**SDG: 4 / 8 / 17**

### Objective:

To provide counseling in order to support and generate development and growth in the businesses situated in Redessa

### Beneficiaries:

18 micro companies and entrepreneurs situated in the available space in Redessa at the City Hall of Reus.

### Implementation and Development:

During this year nine Secot Seniors have attended functions organized by Redessa and have also collaborated in the organization of the Reus Business Awards and also carrying out training for entrepreneurs (such as market studies, quality undertaking, business plans and feasibility studies).

# 07 HIGHLIGHTED PROJECTS AND ACTIONS



## eSemp MADRID SDG: 3 / 4 / 8 / 17

Objective: To capitalize the knowledge and expertise of our Seniors in order to transform it into a valuable quality training product that is useful and sustainable for its users.

Beneficiaries eSemp Madrid: 615 graduates in 2018 from the 4,336 requests received. Courses mainly targeting entrepreneurs who wish to launch a certain business project and who lack the basic knowledge and management skills necessary to create, develop, and implement it, or others small business owners who need to improve according to the aspects of their business. 37 Seniors made up the Faculty.

Implementation and Development: Training sessions including 799 hours in total-took place thanks to the support of The Rafael del Pino Foundation, City Hall of Madrid, and the Comunidad de Madrid.



## ESCUELA MUNICIPAL DE GRANADA SDG: 3 / 4 / 8 / 17

Objective: This program which depends on the Employment Office has the objective to improve the qualifications of those who wish to start up a new business or who have a business idea and to specialize in specific subjects related to the business world.

Beneficiaries: Fundamentally entrepreneurs who need to acquire the skills to open a new business, or to business people who need to specialize in subjects related to the business world. In 2018, 152 students, 66 men, and 86 women mostly unemployed over 45 years old and with a superior level of training benefitted from this project and improved their business knowledge.

Implementation and Development: The training itinerary focuses on the four main principles of a company: Identification of a particular business activity, Marketing and Sales Plan, Human Resources Plan, Financing and Accounting Plan, and Training Exercise.

## COLEGIO ESTUDIO

SDG: 4 / 17

Objective: To enhance the students understanding of business entities through the development of critical thinking, strengthening skills such as communication and reflection as well as leadership, decision making, willingness to work, as well as the development of creativity and innovation in students.

### Beneficiaries:

In the academic course 2018- 2019 45 students from Colegio Estudio of Madrid have received specific training in the project mini companies (Proyecto Miniempresas ) from 8 Secot Seniors Madrid working on a project that entailed 252 hours of training.

### Implementation and Development:

The program is designed to last 15 weeks, during which students will learn to better understand the role of business in our society. In these sessions the Junior Achievement methodology and materials are implemented.



## eSemp BARCELONA Y LEÓN

Objective: To capitalize the knowledge and expertise of our Seniors in order to transform it into a valuable quality training product that is useful and sustainable for all.

### Beneficiaries eSemp Barcelona :

120 graduates and 25 Seniors involved in the training activity.

Beneficiaries eSemp Leon: 180 graduates and 25 Seniors involved in the training activity.

### VODAFONE FOUNDATION

**SDG: 3 / 4 / 17**

#### Objective:

To help close the gap that exists between older people and the world of new technologies so that they learn digital skills through workshops titled “How to get the most from my Smartphone”. These workshops were imparted by Seniors for people over 50.

#### Beneficiaries:

1,598 people over 50 in 2018.

#### Implementation and Development:

30 Seniors from the branches of Barcelona, Madrid, Jaen, Bizkaia, Valladolid, Huesca, Asturias, La Rioja, and Bilbao took part in 124 workshops throughout 8 Autonomous Communities, in a total of 365 hours of training.



### OFICINA EGRESADO EMPRENDEDOR

**SDG: 4 / 8 / 17**

#### Objective:

To motivate and help students discover management competences and skills, as well as business ideas to get them started in the world of business. We are also trying to improve the chances of employment for the graduates of our universities, as well as giving constant attention to those in the last courses or recently graduated from the adjoined campuses of the Universities of Burgos, Leon, Salamanca, and Valladolid.

#### Beneficiaries:

479 attendees at the presentation of the project in the different Universities; 73 tutored graduates, and 145 sessions carried out; 924 attendees at the 47 training sessions held.

#### Implementation and Development:

Over 40 Seniors were involved in the branches of: Valladolid and Leon, University of Burgos, Leon, Valladolid and Salamanca, covering the 13 public university campuses, of Castilla Leon which are located in Aranda de Duero, Avila, Bejar, Burgos, Leon, Miranda de Ebro, Palencia, Ponferrada, Salamanca, Segovia, Soria, Valladolid, and Zamora. 9 offices remain open 293 days looking after the students in a total of 976 hours.





## CAPACIS FOUNDATION

**SDG: 4 / 8 / 17**

### Objective:

To promote the business spirit based on the basic theoretic fundamentals of a business entity and practical workshop where a business is actually created with the same duration as the course. 12 students assisted and there were 13 sessions of one hour and a half.

### Beneficiaries:

Young people with intellectual discapacities.

### Implementation and Development:

During the sessions there was a Capacis monitor along with two Secot Seniors. Also, a workshop was created for practice in personal work interviews, as well as preparation of a Curriculum Vitae (C.V.) This project was made possible thanks to the support of the Obra Social La Caixa a la Fundación Capacis, a non profit organization that helps young people between the ages of 18 – 30 years who have limited intellectual capacities build their own future.

## FONDO DE EMPRENDEDORES

**SDG: 4 / 8 / 17**

### Objective:

The Fondo de Emprendedores is aimed at awarding and supporting the development of the best business projects and businesses in the making in the field of energy efficiency.

### Beneficiaries:

The Fondo selects 5 projects to participate in a process of business incubation for 24 months in which they will receive economic provisions, technological support, and legal and business coordination from a Secot advisor. They also receive help in finding financing for the phase following the incubation process.

### Implementation and Development:

The total number of projects went up to 3, and 4 Seniors were involved. The Seniors total hours reached 420.

### **BANKIA Y F. OPORTUNITAS**

**SDG: 8 / 17**

#### Objective:

To impulse programs of work integration through entrepreneurship, training advising and orientation for vulnerable people.

#### Beneficiaries:

People in a vulnerable situation who have access to the job market through self employment or entrepreneurship. In 2018 we had 10 sessions.

#### Implementation and Development:

25 Secot Seniors collaborated in the training and mentoring of the new entrepreneur and in feasibility studies as well as the development of skills of the future businessman.



### **B-VALUE**

**SDG: 8 / 17**

#### Objective:

To find and award innovative projects that help in orientation and in hiring Young people.

#### Beneficiaries:

Young people having difficulty finding work who can be directed towards the programs that will facilitate their entry in the job market.

#### Implementation and Development:

SECOT as a collaborating member in the project, sponsored by Banco Sabadell – Associate Member of SECOT- y Ship2B. 20 Seniors mentored 10 projects.

Beneficiaries: Users of Madrid’s public transport system.

1.123 Seniors. The indirect beneficiaries are those who received help from the Seniors.

### Implementation And Development:

The Professional Service hired thanks to the Agreement with the Botin Foundation developed a Software Platform for Processing and Data Base, and a management tool for customer relations in 12 months. Training workshops have taken place in Secot Madrid and Secot Barcelona.

### Beneficiaries:

Aimed towards people over 55 placing special interest in recruiting women members as SECOT volunteers. We noted a 20% increase in the incorporation of females in Seniors and Adhered Members.

### Implementation and Development:

During 2018, 24 training sessions have taken place, along with conferences, actions for publicity and raising public awareness ,work meetings, and mentoring sessions.. Additionally work alliances have been formed with organizations such as ASEME, omenalia, and JAEM.

It is aimed at reinforcing social relations for elderly people who feel alone and to improve their well being through technology and through teams of social boosting.

The City Hall will lend these people a Tablet with an installed application with internet connection in order to use the Vincles BCN application. SECOT Barcelona collaborates in this project with the City Hall of Barcelona and the Vodafone Foundation.

## Informe de auditoría de cuentas anuales abreviadas emitido por un auditor independiente

A la Asamblea de Seniors Españoles para la Cooperación Técnica:

### Opinión

Hemos auditado las cuentas anuales abreviadas de **Seniors Españoles para la Cooperación Técnica** (la Asociación), que comprenden el balance abreviado a 31 de diciembre de 2018, la cuenta de pérdidas y ganancias abreviada, y la memoria abreviada correspondientes al ejercicio terminado en dicha fecha.

En nuestra opinión, las cuentas anuales abreviadas adjuntas expresan, en todos los aspectos significativos, la imagen fiel del patrimonio y de la situación financiera de la Asociación a 31 de diciembre de 2018, así como de sus resultados al ejercicio terminado en dicha fecha, de conformidad con el marco normativo de información financiera que resulta de aplicación (que se identifica en la nota 2 de la memoria abreviada) y, en particular, con los principios y criterios contables contenidos en el mismo.

### Fundamento de la opinión

Hemos llevado a cabo nuestra auditoría de conformidad con la normativa reguladora de la actividad de auditoría de cuentas vigente en España. Nuestras responsabilidades de acuerdo con dichas normas se describen más adelante en la sección *Responsabilidades del auditor en relación con la auditoría de las cuentas anuales abreviadas* de nuestro Informe.

Somos independientes de la Asociación de conformidad con los requerimientos de ética, incluidos los de independencia, que son aplicables a nuestra auditoría de las cuentas anuales en España según lo exigido por la normativa reguladora de la actividad de auditoría de cuentas. En este sentido, no hemos prestado servicios distintos a los de la auditoría de cuentas ni han concurrido situaciones o circunstancias que, de acuerdo con lo establecido en la citada normativa reguladora, hayan afectado a la necesaria independencia de modo que se haya visto comprometida.

Consideramos que la evidencia de auditoría que hemos obtenido proporciona una base suficiente y adecuada para nuestra opinión.

### Aspectos más relevantes de la auditoría

Los aspectos más relevantes de la auditoría son aquellos que, según nuestro juicio profesional, han sido considerados como los riesgos de incorrección material más significativos en nuestra auditoría de las cuentas anuales abreviadas del periodo actual. Estos riesgos han sido tratados en el contexto de nuestra auditoría de las cuentas anuales abreviadas en su conjunto, y en la formación de nuestra opinión sobre éstas, y no expresamos una opinión por separado sobre esos riesgos.

Hemos determinado que no existen riesgos más significativos considerados en la auditoría que deban comunicarse en nuestro informe.

### Responsabilidad de la Junta Directiva en relación con las cuentas anuales abreviadas

La Junta Directiva es responsable de formular las cuentas anuales abreviadas adjuntas, de forma que expresen la imagen fiel del patrimonio, de la situación financiera y de los resultados de la Asociación, de conformidad con el marco normativo de información financiera aplicable a la Entidad en España, y del control interno que considere necesario para permitir la preparación de cuentas anuales abreviadas libres de incorrección material, debida a fraude o error.

En la preparación de las cuentas anuales abreviadas, la Junta Directiva es responsable de la valoración de la capacidad de la Asociación para continuar como empresa en funcionamiento, revelando, según corresponda, las cuestiones relacionadas con la empresa en funcionamiento y utilizando el principio contable de empresa en funcionamiento excepto si la Junta Directiva tiene intención de liquidar la Asociación o de cesar sus operaciones, o bien no exista otra alternativa realista.

### Responsabilidades del auditor en relación con la auditoría de las cuentas anuales abreviadas

Nuestros objetivos son obtener una seguridad razonable de que las cuentas anuales abreviadas en su conjunto están libres de incorrección material, debida a fraude o error, y emitir un informe de auditoría que contiene nuestra opinión. Seguridad razonable es un alto grado de seguridad pero no garantiza que una auditoría realizada de conformidad con la normativa reguladora de la actividad de auditoría de cuentas vigente en España siempre detecte una incorrección material cuando existe. Las incorrecciones pueden deberse a fraude o error y se consideran materiales si, individualmente o de forma agregada, puede preverse razonablemente que influyan en las decisiones económicas que los usuarios toman basándose en las cuentas anuales abreviadas.

Como parte de una auditoría de conformidad con la normativa reguladora de la actividad de auditoría de cuentas vigente en España, aplicamos nuestro juicio profesional y mantenemos una actitud de escepticismo profesional durante toda la auditoría. También:

- Identificamos y valoramos los riesgos de incorrección material en las cuentas anuales abreviadas, debida a fraude o error, diseñamos y aplicamos procedimientos de auditoría para responder a dichos riesgos y obtenemos evidencia de auditoría suficiente y adecuada para proporcionar una base para nuestra opinión. El riesgo de no detectar una incorrección material debida a fraude es más elevado que en el caso de una incorrección material debida a error, ya que el fraude puede implicar colusión, falsificación, omisiones deliberadas, manifestaciones intencionadamente erróneas, o la elusión del control interno.
- Obtenemos conocimiento del control interno relevante para la auditoría con el fin de diseñar procedimientos de auditoría que sean adecuados en función de las circunstancias, y no con la finalidad de expresar una opinión sobre la eficacia del control interno de la Entidad.

Si concluimos que existe una incertidumbre material, se requiere que llamemos la atención en nuestro informe de auditoría sobre la correspondiente información revelada en las cuentas anuales abreviadas o, si dichas revelaciones no son adecuadas, que expresemos una opinión modificada. Nuestras conclusiones se basan en la evidencia de auditoría obtenida hasta la fecha de nuestro informe de auditoría. Sin embargo, los hechos o condiciones futuros pueden ser la causa de que la Asociación deje de ser una empresa en funcionamiento.

- Evaluamos la presentación global, la estructura y el contenido de las cuentas anuales abreviadas, incluida la información revelada, y si las cuentas anuales abreviadas representan las transacciones y hechos subyacentes de un modo que logran expresar la imagen fiel.

Nos comunicamos con la Junta Directiva de la Entidad en relación con, entre otras cuestiones, el alcance y el momento de realización de la auditoría planificada y los hallazgos significativos de la auditoría, así como cualquier deficiencia significativa del control interno que identificamos en el transcurso de la auditoría.

Entre los riesgos significativos que han sido objeto de comunicación a la Junta Directiva de la Entidad, determinamos los que han sido de la mayor significatividad en la auditoría de las cuentas anuales abreviadas del periodo actual y que son, en consecuencia, los riesgos considerados más significativos.

Describimos esos riesgos en nuestro informe de auditoría salvo que las disposiciones legales o reglamentarias prohíban revelar públicamente la cuestión.
